The Lead Pastor will provide day to day leadership and support to the DCC Leadership and Ministry Team and congregation.

Providing leadership within the five fold ministry team they will be responsible for the fulfilment of God's vision for the Church.

They will also be responsible for setting preaching, teaching and training priorities. They will also play an integral role in assisting DCC's ministry leaders to develop the ministry and reach of the Church further.
